Fishing Rodeo Official Rules and Regulations

Louisiana (RS 14:214). Fishing contest fraud is a crime in the state of Louisiana

- **1.** All State and Federal Fish Regulations apply to the Battle Between the Bayous Fishing Rodeo.
- 2. All Rodeo events, including the weigh-in, will be held at: Sweetwater Marina, 6205 Delacroix Hwy, St Bernard, LA 70085.
- **3.** All eligible fish must be caught by rod, reel, hook and line only. Live bait can be used.
- **4.** Non frozen, spoiled, gutted, altered, mutilated fish will be accepted by the Weigh-Master. Any attempt to defraud or cheat in the Rodeo, in any way, will automatically disqualify the offender and all his/her fish as well as subject the person/s to potential imprisonment and fines (RS 14:214). All fish weighed will be designated by the Weigh-Master clipping the dorsal or tail fin, but can remain property of the contestant.
- **5.** All fish must be weighted on the designated Rodeo scale. Only fish weighed on the designated Rodeo scale by the Battle Between the Bayous designated Weigh-Master will be eligible for participation. Fish will be weighed only one time. The Weigh-Master has final authority on declaring weights and fish condition. Weigh-Master decision cannot be overruled by anyone. Excessive arguing with Rodeo organizer or the Weigh-Master will result in disqualification.
- **6.** In the event of a categorical tie, the fish that weighted-in first shall be declared the winner.

- **7.** Fishing starts at 6:30p.m. on Saturday, November 2nd and ends at 3:00p.m. on Saturday, November 2nd. Weigh-in will open at 12:00p.m. and close at 3:00p.m. sharp on Saturday, November 2nd. Fish must be weighed in by 3:00p.m.
- **8.** Cash prizes will be awarded to the top 8 people participants with the heaviest combined weight of 3 speckled trout and 2 redfish. The redfish must be between 16-27in. The trout must be 12 inches. Whichever boat has the heaviest combined weight of 3 speckled trout and 2 redfish (the first place winners boat), the captain will determine the school that we present the check to. The lengths must be met at the time of weigh in.
- **9.** It is the responsibility of each participant to read and follow all the rules of Battle Between the Bayous Fishing Rodeo and those mandated by State and Federal regulations.
- **10.** It is expressly understood that all participants in the Battle between the Bayous Fishing Rodeo enter at their own risk, and that Sweetwater Marina, sponsors of the Battle Between the Bayous Fishing Rodeo, and all persons connected directly and indirectly with the operation of said rodeo shall be exempt from liability for libel, slander, loss, damage, negligence, harm, injury, or death suffered by any participants, boat captains, crew members, vessels and equipment which may occur during or in the connection with the Rodeo.
 - 11. All participants, by their attendance at the Rodeo, agree to indemnify Sweetwater Marina and Battle Between the Bayous Fishing Rodeo. By rodeo entry the captain or owner contest that the Battle Between the Bayous Fishing Rodeo may use without payment or restriction any photographs in which he/she or any of their crew may appear for any purpose whatsoever, including but not limited to resale, advertising, commercial or promotional material. The captain, owners and his crew further release the Battle Between the Bayous Fishing Rodeo operators, sponsors, and all persons directly or indirectly related to the Rodeo from injury, loss or damage that may result from participation in the Rodeo.
